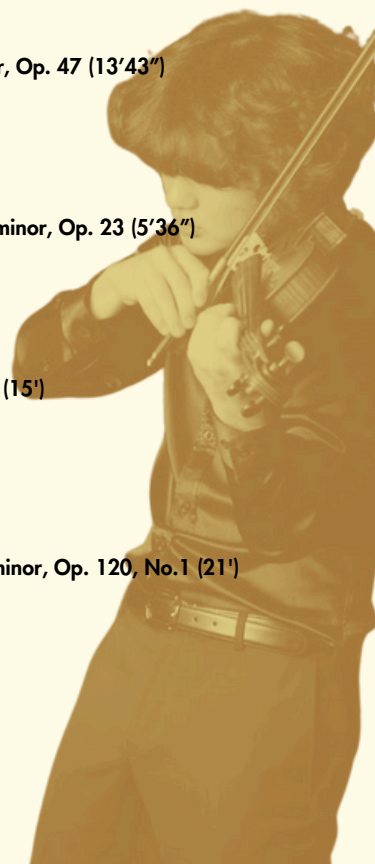

2021 STULBERG INTERNATIONAL STRING COMPETITION - BRONZE MEDALIST

BOBBY BOOGEOM PARK (18) is a freshman at the Juilliard School studying with Itzhak Perlman and Li Lin under the Kovner Fellowship – an honorary full scholarship and career benefits granted to the highest achieving students at Juilliard. In the past, Bobby was a student of the Juilliard Pre-College Division where he studied with Donald Weilerstein and Catherine Cho for 7 years. He has attended the Perlman Music Program Summer Music School in the summer for the past three years.

Bobby has been a guest soloist at international concerts and festivals including the Shanghai International Arts Festival at Oriental Art Center in Shanghai. He was a 1st prize winner at the International Russian Rotary Music Competition in Moscow and the 2019 Juilliard Pre-College Concerto Competition. He has been awarded other numerous first prizes in domestic competitions in Korea and China. In 2018, he made his New York debuts at Lincoln Center and Carnegie Hall after winning first prize at the New York International Music Competition and first prize winner and the Judge's distinction award at the American Protégé International Music Competition. As first-prize winner at the 2018 New York Chamber Players Orchestra Concerto Competition, he performed with the New York Chamber Players Orchestra and he was re-invited to the NYCP Concert at Carnegie Hall. In 2020 he was awarded both the first and grand prize for the Camerata Artists International Competition and performed with the CNJO orchestra at Merkin Hall of the Kaufman Music Center. In 2021, at the age of 15, Bobby was the bronze medalist at the Stulberg International String Competition, selected as the youngest of 8 semifinalists in the Klein Competition, and Gold Prize Winner of the Vienna International Music Competition. Last year, Bobby was awarded the First Great Award and Golden Medal with High Distinction at the Manhattan International Music Competition.

He performed with KJSO orchestra in Kalamazoo, Michigan, and was featured on WMUK Radio program. Also, Bobby was featured in the Stars of Tomorrow concert twice at the Heifetz Institute. He is a member of Concert in Motion and performs there regularly every year to give performances for elderly and homebound patrons since 2017. Bobby was featured on NPR radio show "From the Top" with violinist Tessa Lark. He also was featured on the From the Top 20-21 Season All-Star concert.

He was selected as a performer in the Dorothy Delay Master Class Series with Vadim Repin. Bobby has also been invited to several house concerts, including to congratulate the new incoming Chief of Department of the NYPD, and to celebrate the election victory of NYC mayor Eric Adams.

He has served as the concertmaster of the Juilliard Pre-College String Orchestra, Juilliard Pre-College Symphony Orchestra under the direction of Maestra Daniela Candillari, and the Juilliard Pre-College Orchestra under the direction of Maestro Earl Lee. He has also served as the concertmaster of the LaGuardia Philharmonic Orchestra. As a freshman at the Juilliard School, Bobby has served as the concertmaster of the Juilliard Orchestra Orientation under the baton of David Robertson.

In 2022, Bobby was featured on NY1 News Channel as a first prize winner and a soloist of the LaGuardia Concerto Competition. In 2022, Bobby performed with Maxim Vengerov and the Oxford Philharmonic Orchestra in Stern Auditorium at Carnegie Hall. In June of 2023, Bobby has performed at the Perlman Music Program's Annual Wine Gala and Charity Auction hosted by Mr. and Mrs. Perlman, and also participated as a student artist in the 2023 Starling-Delay Violin Symposium hosted by the Juilliard School. In September of 2023, Bobby and his quartet group performed the first movement of Mozart's "Hunt" quartet representing the Pre-College Division at the Annual Season Preview event hosted by the Juilliard School.

In the fall of 2023, Bobby was selected as a 2024 YoungArts Winner with Distinction. Recently, he was featured on Teen Kids News as a 2024 YoungArts Winner with Distinction. In the month of December of 2023, Bobby has performed at the reception event of the Itzhak Perlman and the Juilliard String Quartet concert taking place in Alice Tully Hall, and two special events in Jupiter and Palm Beach, representing the Perlman Music Program. This year, Bobby was selected as a semifinalist for the 2024 U.S. Presidential Scholars in the Arts.

During this past summer, Bobby was chosen to participate as the youngest student performer of Maxim Vengerov Masterclass: Mozart Concerto with Orchestra hosted by Carnegie Hall coming up in November. Bobby is a proud recipient of a Kovner Fellowship at the Juilliard School.
